

# Enjoy Library eBooks on your eBook Reader



For transfer from PC/Mac to most e-ink device

## Setup software on PC or ivia:

- a. Make sure your device is plugged into your computer.
- b. Install Adobe Digital Editions on your computer:

#### 2 Authorize software lone time

- a. Open Adobe Digital Editions. Under the Help tab, select Authorize Computer.
- b. Choose Adobe ID as your eBook vendor and enter your Adobe ID and password.

  If you do not have an Adobe ID, click Create an Adobe ID.
  - i. Follow the instructions to sign up for an Adobe ID.
  - ii. Return to the 'Computer Authorization' window.
  - iii. Enter your Adobe ID and password.
- c. Click Authorize, then click OK.

# 3. Borrow from your library's digital collection

- a. On your computer, browse for a title from your library's digital collection website.
- b. Borrow the title using your library card or student ID.
- c. Download the title to your PC or Mac.

# 4. Transfer to your eBook reage

- a. When you download your title, Adobe Digital Editions opens automatically.
- b. Drag and drop the Adobe eBook to your eBook reader (under 'Devices').\* When the transfer is complete, disconnect the eBook reader and enjoy.
- \* Note: If you do not see your device, you may need to install some additional software. Please check your device's documentation for more information.

# To deliver Kindle<sup>®</sup> books to Kindle devices

#### Browse

- Visit your library's digital collection website.
- Browse or search for a Kindle Book to borrow. On public library websites, you can filter search
  results by format to view only titles available in Kindle Book format. Please make sure that Kindle
  Book format is available for the title you want to borrow.

· Borrow the title using your library card or student ID.

#### Deliver to Kindle

- From your library bookshelf, select Download > Kindle Book > Confirm & Download.
- On Amazon's website, click Get library book (requires Amazon account sign in).
- Select the Kindle device or Kindle reading app to which you want to deliver the library eBook.
   This requires active Wi-Fi or 4G connection for wireless delivery, or may be transferred via USB from PC or Mac.
